



Covid Code of Conduct

It is the responsibility of all Competitors, Coaches, Volunteers and Spectators who attend Henley Women's Regatta to understand and follow this Code of Conduct. Failure to comply with the Code could lead to the closure of the event, as such it is imperative that all parties understand their responsibilities.

- Keep 2 metres apart from people outside of your social bubble.
- Regularly wash your hands, use hand sanitiser and avoid touching your face.
- Please scan in the QR code on arrival, using the NHS Covid 19 app.
- Wear masks when in any buildings/enclosed spaces or where you are unable to keep 2 metres apart.
- Spectators must not enter the trailer park or boating area. These areas are for Competitors only.
- Spectators & Competitors should wear their wrist bands at all times.
- Competitors should remain in the trailer or at their Gazebo except when competing.
- There are restrictions on capacity in all building/enclosed spaces including toilets - please comply with any specific rules displayed prior to entry.
- Avoid congregating in large groups. Please respect the maximum number of 30 in a group outside.

- In line with BR guidance, shouting for crews is strongly discouraged, instead we ask that you clap for competitors.
- Please respect all event officials and follow instructions provided.
- Failure to comply with this code of conduct may lead to crew disqualification.
